



Estate:

White Rock Vineyards produces elegant and balanced Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, Claret and Chardonnay, using only the fruit from our own vineyard. Our 36-acre family run estate is situated in its own small valley in the southern foothills of the Stag's Leap Range on the historic site of White Rock Vineyards, which dates back to 1870. With a commitment to sustainable natural farming. We have never used herbicides, pesticides, or fumigants in our vineyard. We practice an integrated soil management program designed to ensure the health and fertility of our soils, including native cover crops, hand hoeing and mulching around the vines.

Winemaker Notes:

The 2016 Cabernet is 100% estate Cabernet blended from the east and west facing hillsides. It is a dark and silky wine with blackberry jam, mocha and exotic wood aromas. Richly layered with black cherry, star-thistle and cedars flavors, with significant structure, refined tannins and a long finish.
