

Estate White Rock Vineyards produces elegant and balanced Napa Valley Chardonnay, Claret and

Cabernet Sauvignon, from fruit farmed on our family estate. Our 36-acre family run farm is situated in its own small valley in the southern foothills of the Stag's Leap Range on the historic site of White Rock Vineyards, which dates back to 1870. With a commitment to sustainable natural farming. We have never used herbicides, pesticides, or fumigants in our vineyard. We practice an integrated soil management program designed to ensure the health and fertility of

our soils, including native cover crops, hand hoeing and mulching around the vines.
